If you need a clothes rack, this must be brought from home

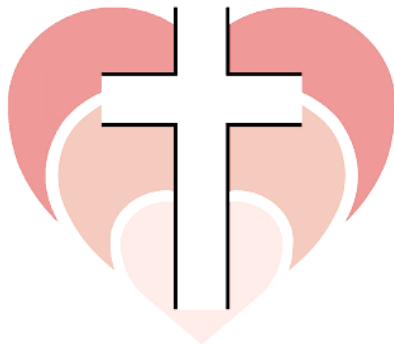

Pastor's Word - Fall 2025
"As children of God, we are called to intercession"

Ephesians 6:10-20

"Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and being watchful in this, always persevering in prayer for all the saints"

In the pastor's word for the spring of 2025, we talked about how we are not in this world by chance or accident. We are here for a purpose, and that is to seek the kingdom of God above all else, and to love our neighbor as ourselves.

The idea is that we should forget all our own plans and ideas, and instead we should concentrate on doing as Jesus did, when he walked with his disciples, and therefore instead follow divine love.

We do this, among other things, by being aware of the importance of prayer and the necessity of interceding for the congregation, the entire body of Christ.

Remember that when God blesses us, it is to give us the opportunity to bless our neighbors.

For this to be successful, it is important to understand who and what we are in relation to God.

To better understand this, let us look at the prayer that the Lord taught his disciples, namely the Lord's Prayer, which we find in Matthew 6:9-15.

When it is about God, it is spoken in the singular, you, yours, and yours!

You who are in heaven! Hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven;

For yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever! Amen.

But when it is not about God, but about people, it is spoken in the plural, us, we, and ours!

Our Father, give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our debts, as we also forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

The condition of man after the fall and up to Christ was that we were all lost as individuals and as a group and there was nothing we could do about it.

But then God intervened, as it says in John 3:16.

"For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life."

Here we see that it is God and only He who intervenes and offers something to people.

A salvation that is for all people, regardless of race, nationality, gender, age and cultural background.

Although salvation applies to all people, it cannot be received collectively, but must be received and experienced by the individual person.

When we accept and receive salvation in faith, we are, as the scripture says, born again (John 3:1-21)

When the individual person has received salvation in faith and experienced being born again, he becomes a child of God and part of his family, and we become part of the body of Christ.

When we as individuals have received salvation, we have now become part of a new community, now it is no longer called I, but now it is called us.

And when we pray, as the Lord has taught us, it is a common prayer that applies to all God's children.

Therefore, it is also important that we understand that when we pray, it is not just about me and mine. It is about us, together with all of God's children, being able to come boldly before our heavenly father.

As children of God, it is important that we are aware of our ministry of intercession, and that we are not so focused on ourselves and our own needs that we forget to intercede for the rest of God's family.

Remember that as part of God's family, we are called to pray for one another and bless one another

And we can pray both for ourselves and intercede for the rest of the body of Christ and whomever else the Holy Spirit puts on our minds.

Love was the guiding principle in Jesus' own life.

God's love can also lead us to pray for the people he wants to reach out to and care for.

It only requires that we are ready and willing to follow love, wherever and whenever that may be.

Remember that *"the effective prayer of a righteous person is powerful"* (James 5:16)

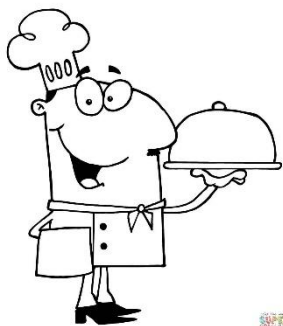
